Mandatory meeting to learn about the program and the specific research projects being offered. Students will go through first round of interviewing.

Summer Science Internship Orientation: **June 12, 2017**

Selected students will begin their internship with orientation and training.

Summer Science Forum: **August 3, 2017**

Students will present their experience through oral presentations and scientific posters.
